### Sustainable Wines 🌿

Sustainable Vineyards use a variety of methods, based on what the farmer decides is best, instead of following a rigid set of practices. The focus of sustainable wineries is striving for greener operations overall, often by lowering waste and emissions and conserving water.

### Organic Wines 🌿🌿

Vineyards using organically grown grapes are without any added sulphites or chemicals. Organically grown grapes are grown in accordance with principles of organic farming, which typically excludes the use of artificial chemical fertilisers, pesticides, fungicides and herbicides.

### Biodynamic Wines 🌿🌿🌿

Biodynamic farming is like organic farming in many ways. The method uses no chemicals on the plants or in the soil, but has extra practices to go along with it. The biodynamic vineyard is part of an ecosystem that is scheduled using astrology and lunar cycles. Biodynamic viticulture is a philosophy combining the maintenance of sustainable soil fertility and the recognition of the link between plant growth and the rhythms of the cosmos.

### Did You Know?

Biodynamic soils have been tested against non-organic soils and they showed greater disease suppression, a decrease in compaction and added organic material. Converting from a conventional vineyard to an organic one is a three-year process that involves regular inspection. Organizations such as the Soil Association in the UK and Ecocert in France award the certification.

### Did You Know?

In biodynamic culture, various “ingredients” are added to the compost according to needs:

Milfoil: it allows to reduce sulphur spraying of the vine

Chamomile: it regulates the nitrogen processes

Stinging nettle: very effective against mildew

Oak bark: it attenuates plant diseases

Dandelion: it promotes the resistance against mushroom penetration
